Premier Sevens 2017

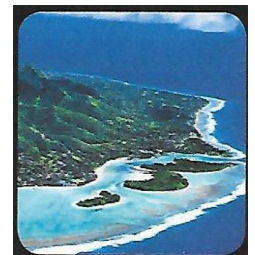
